

I was found financially ineligible for regular unemployment compensation

What do I do?

Is the decision missing wages? The government only considers certain wages for your claim:

I filed my application in:	Your eligibility will be based on wages paid in:
March 2020	October 2018 - September 2019
April - June 2020	January 2019 - December 2019
July - September 2020	April 2019 - March 2020
October - December 2020	July 2019 - June 2020
January 2021 - March 2021	October 2019 - September 2020

Next Steps:



If missing wages, appeal within the deadline (15 days)

- Provide evidence of your earnings
- Email ucappeals@pa.gov with your name, SSN, and a description of your earnings and attached proof



If no wages are missing and you lost work due to COVID-19, apply for Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA)




If you did not lose work due to COVID-19, you can reapply in the next "quarter" of the year, when the government will consider different wages:

This chart tells you what time period of earnings the government will consider when determining your financial eligibility for UC

The time period changes every "quarter" (every three months)

If you are not financially eligible in one quarter, the law allows you to file a new claim during the next time period
